WHEREAS, the Captaincy of Dabat and the government has issued the Decree No. 07/2013, reorganizing the structure of Article 1, Decree of National History, National Archives Office and the Plenary Assembly Committee, to establish and implement the Registry System for Books Edition in Paraguay (REBRA).




WHEREAS, the Constitution provides that the LGU through its Local Chief Executive is mandated to protect the lives of its people;

WHEREAS, the observance of the feast day of the patroness is one of our people's most cherished social and religious traditions;



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 03-2012

AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF PROGRAM ON CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION AND THE FORMATION OF THE CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION NETWORK (CAPIN) UNDER THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN.

WHEREAS, the United Nation's Convention on the Rights of the Child affirms the vulnerability of children and that every child has the right to protection from abuse before and after birth, and the 1996 law of the Convention recognizes the welfare of child first;

WHEREAS, every child has an inherent right to life and that there has been significant concern that children survive and develop;

WHEREAS, the National Constitution guarantees the rights of children to education, including special protection from all forms of neglect, abuse, exploitation and other conditions impeding their development;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Santa Rita, Pampanga is committed to uphold standards made by forming programs and mechanisms to ensure the survival, development, protection, and participation of children as mandated by the Constitution;

WHEREAS, one of basic rights is the right of children to be protected from all forms of abuse and maltreatment;

WHEREAS, there is need to coordinate and unify the DSC operations, territorial and implementation of the government's action on a mandatory basis in accordance with the 1990 Law: Government Code of the Philippines;

NOW THEREFORE, I, **MARIA R. MEDINA, Mayor, Municipal Government of Santa Rita, Pampanga**, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby issue and direct the following:

Section 1. Program Concept, Purpose, and Creation of a Multi-Sectorality Team. RA. 7650 provides government agencies to form a cooperative program to protect children and prevent all forms of abuse. This multi-agency program is a multi-faceted measure. On the other hand, each government agency tasked to form different offices of abuse has its own set of guidelines, procedures which may cause redefinition of the child. Drugging the abused child around different offices where s/he is supposed to cooperate and collaborate, creating unnecessary hindrance to the safety and welfare of the child.

It is, therefore, the Municipal Government of Santa Rita, Pampanga, the intention, the desire to accomplish the creation of a CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION NETWORK (CAPIN) under the Municipal Council for the Protection of Children.

CAPIN is envisioned to consist in a group of caring government and non-government professionals who are authorized to put the child at center in delivery plan of the helping relationship. These professionals are responsible to provide services in an integrated and systematic manner that responds to the varied CAPIN's needs in a child friendly area, is able to establish a Multi-Sectorality Team (MST) and create an Unbiased and transparent mechanism that ensures maximum safety and welfare of the child.

Section 3. Function of CDRM: It shall be the intent that the Protection Rights of Children are upheld, therefore the following conditions:

1. Advocate for the passing of local ordinance adopting the CDRM as a special provision in regard to child abuse cases.
2. Facilitate the inclusion of the components to ensure that no child abuse cases of spouse, neglect, exploitation, and discrimination including children in sync with the law in the local Development Plan of the Municipality through the Municipal Council for the Protection of Children to ensure sustainability and institutional order;
3. Agree to enter in existing cases involving children in a confidential and child friendly manner to avoid multiple trauma to a child victim through the coordination of Women and Children Protection Unit;
4. Provide capacity building programs to CDRM members in addressing cases of child abuse and exploitation and other interventions for victims of such cases;
5. Adoption of the Child Care Management (CCM) in all transactions of CDRM unit;
6. Update and undertake advocacy campaign in ensuring greater awareness, understanding, and improvement of services for child abuse victims.

Section 4. Secretariat Support: The secretaries shall be update in the following body: MTRM and concerned offices are shall be responsible for the documentation of the proceedings and meetings, preparation of norms and rules necessary documents needed by the committee.

Section 5. Effectiveness: This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
